

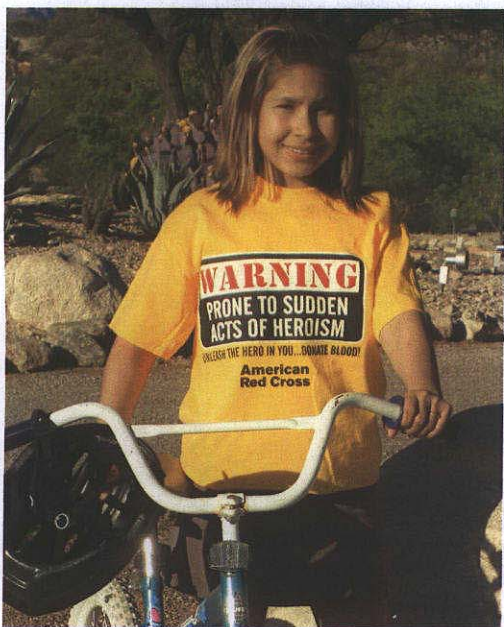
Recycle Life - Donate Blood
